Body text must be double-spaced. Font must be Times New Roman or a similar serif font, and 12 point. Footnotes must be 10 point and single-spaced.. Citations must conform to the 22nd Ed. of *The Bluebook*, and grammar and syntax should generally conform to *The Chicago Manual of Style* 18th Ed. **The author's name should NOT appear anywhere on the paper.** Only one entry will be accepted per student or student co-authors.
